



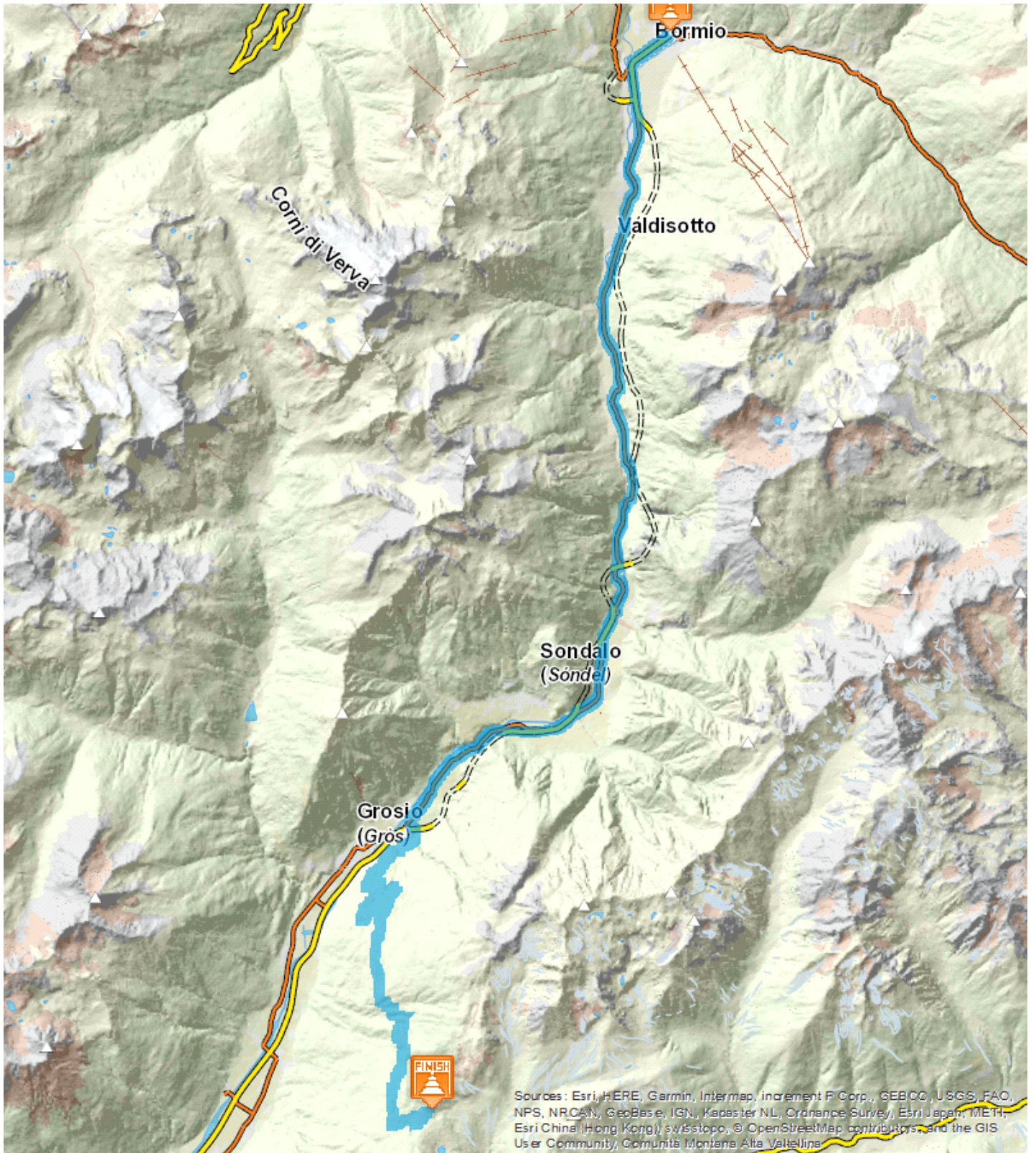

The easiest slope but not entirely a breeze to reach Mortirolo Pass. It offers an extraordinary PANORAMA, with typical Alpine mountainscapes, fields, and characteristic baite chalets. It lives in the shadow of other better known routes but at any rate it offers a challenging alternative to those for whom Mortirolo is too difficult. Over the last three kilometres, the road winds just above the legendary trail.



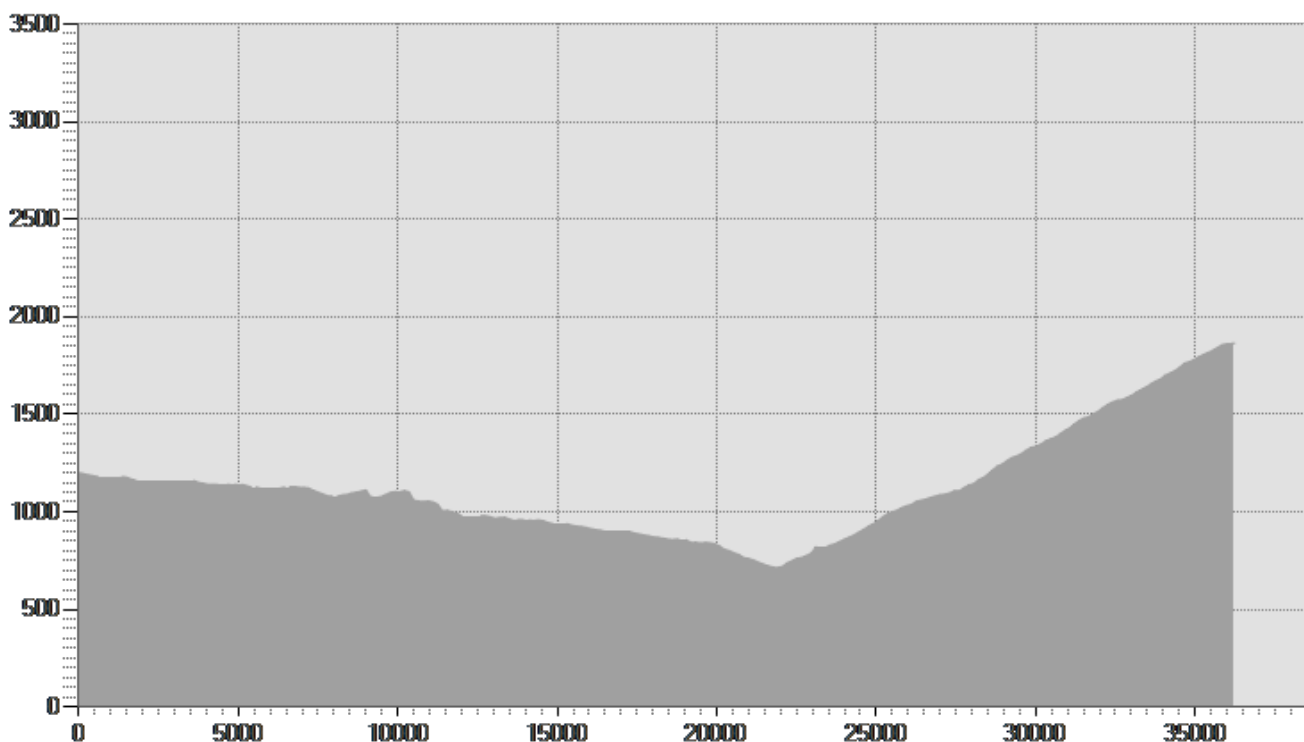
